Supervisor Joe Baca, Jr. Encourages the Community to Participate in National Pet Adoption Week

San Bernardino, CA.- Supervisor Joe Baca, Jr. is encouraging those in and out of our community to participate in “National Adopt a Shelter Pet Day,” which is on Saturday, April 30th this year. Supervisor Baca, Jr. is partnering with Devore Animal Shelter to help raise awareness about the importance of adopting pets from shelters. The shelter will have a 5-day period where fees to adopt a pet will be reduced.

From April 29th- May 6th the fees to adopt a dog will be reduced to \$25.00 and the fee to adopt a cat will be reduced to \$17.00. This sponsored fee includes the pet adoption, spay/neutering sterilization, initial vaccinations, and microchip costs.
